Norman Park Track Floodlights

The Club has just signed a contract to have the lights at Norman Park upgraded. This will involve replacing the existing lights, but not the pylons, with brighter, modern energy efficient lights. The cost will be £70,000 and work is planned to start in the spring of 2026.
